

RECTOR'S DECISION No. 7/2002

OBSERVANCE OF THE COPYRIGHT ACT

The Act No. 121/2000 Coll. on Copyright, on Rights Related to Copyright and on Alterations to Other Acts in the valid version (hereinafter referred to as the "Act" only), which came into effect on 1 December 2000, regulates the rights of authors on their work, rights related to copyright, rights of database creators on databases created by them, protection of rights in accordance with this Act and collective administration of copyright and rights related to copyright.

All employees and students of Tomas Bata University in Zlín (hereinafter referred to as "TBU" only) are provided with Internet access. When using the Internet and/or when running a software, they must honour licence agreements.

The employees and students of Tomas Bata University in Zlín are not allowed to illegally download, store, install, copy and diffuse software products protected by the Act, including audio and video recordings as well as films, using the computers placed in the university buildings and in buildings rented by the University. Products protected by copyright are marked as "Copy Read".

If a TBU student defies the above-mentioned ban, this is considered as a disciplinary offence to be treated in accordance with the valid Disciplinary Code of TBU in Zlín. If a TBU employee defies the above-mentioned ban, this is considered as a breach of labour discipline and treated in compliance with the Labour Code in the valid version. Furthermore, in case of breach of provisions of this Decision and in compliance with § 152 of the Penal Code in the valid version, it might be possible to bring a complaint against the respective student/employee.

The administrators of the TBU servers or the administrators of individual parts of the mentioned servers (WWW, FTP) are responsible for the software on the TBU servers. The administrators of student computer rooms are responsible for software on computers placed in the student computer rooms. The employee materially responsible for a computer is also responsible for the software on the respective computer. Students using the personal computers and/or notebooks in the TBU Residence Halls are responsible for the use of the respective computers.

This Decision comes into effect on the day on which it was confirmed.
